Student Safety and Well Being

As a community, we need to support each other to create a safe environment for our students. Establishing protocols to ensure Student Safety is a high priority in any school.

We ask that all parents and carers of students at Cranbourne Primary School please respect the following:

- + Between 9.00am and 3.15pm contact with the school is done via the office only – do not enter the learning spaces or approach staff during these times, unless you have registered at the office and have a visitor's pass.
- + If you are collecting your child before the regular finish time you must go to the office first and sign them out – you will be issued with a pass to give to the teacher – students will not be released from the class without the office pass.
- + Bring any issues you have about other students or family members to the attention of staff – do not approach students and discuss problems that you or your child are having.
- + Parents and carers are to be patient at the office at the end of the school day and allow staff to deal with student issues first.
- + Students who arrive at school after 9.00am are to be escorted to the office by parent/carer, where they are to be signed in as 'late arrivals' – do not leave your child at the gate to walk in alone.

If these practices are followed, we can then ensure your children's safety and well being.
