CURRICULUM NEWS

Another term is coming to an end and our students and staff have worked very hard to achieve great learning and teaching outcomes. During the holiday break it is important that good learning habits are not completely forgotten!

During the break encourage your child to read regularly - and to read a variety of material, not just books. Talk to your child about what they have read, but remember to ask those deeper questions. Ask your child to explain why something happened in the story - not just what actually happened. Ask your child to express their opinion of what they read - why they liked or didn't like it.

A great activity for the holidays is to go to the movies and there are lots of children's movies being released for the holiday break. Please remember to consider the ratings of any movie you are planning to see, to ensure it is appropriate for your child's age and emotional maturity.

Keeping your child 'entertained' during the holiday break does not have to cost a fortune. Doing things together at home or in the local community can be as much fun as costly outings and holidays. But most importantly, spend time with your family, have fun together and talk to each other.
