Thank you to Mr Peel for organising their participation and for attending the day, acting as a marshall in the shot put event.

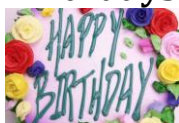

NAPLAN

The Department of Early Education & Childhood Development (DEECD) has returned the results of our NAPLAN Assessment for 2013.

These results are a snapshot of how students in Grade 3 and Grade 5 are doing at school as compared to other students of the same age across the country (National).

These assessments were conducted earlier in the year, therefore are not an indication of where the students are at now with their learning but where they were at 6 months ago.

These reports are assessing students against the new National Curriculum AusVELS and not VELS. Students in Year 3 and Year 5 will receive their personal NAPLAN results next week.
