*All students at CPS have been registered to participate, so please encourage your child to accept the challenge and READ!*

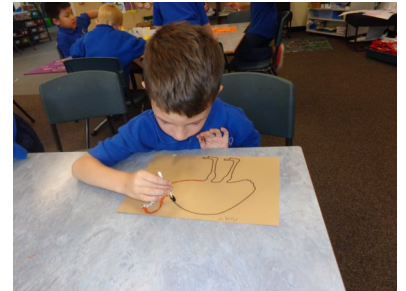

We are still using Jolly Phonics at the start of each morning and we have now progressed from sounds to blends.



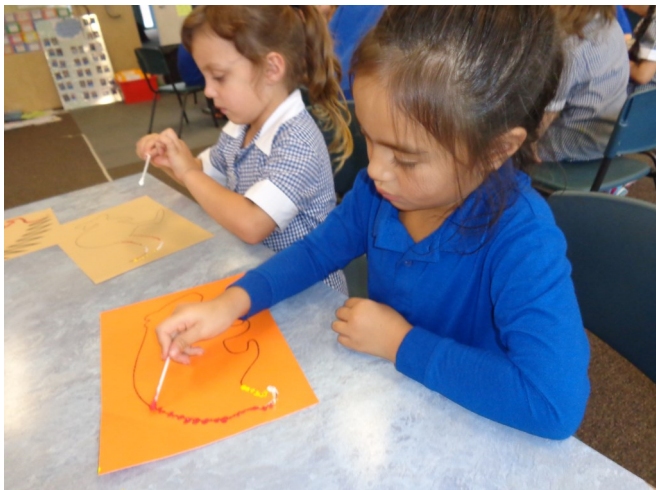
We are learning to brainstorm topics such as bikes and leaves, and to sort our words into relevant groups in writing.
