The next Unit of Investigation will be **The Olympics!**

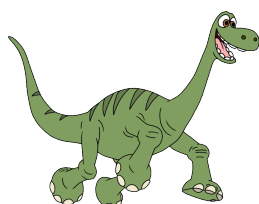
Students will be learning about sports, location of countries competing, all about the host nation.
