PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

The Launch into Learning program has started the year with the establishment of positive relationships and productive learning environments. Congratulations to all the staff who have worked collaboratively on such a successful start to the year.

This Friday at assembly we will be presenting the student leadership badges. We would be delighted for parents to join us at 2.30 in the gym to support all our students. There were many students who presented speeches throughout the week to be considered for a leadership position. If your child 'had a go' then it would be lovely for you to support their efforts, whether they were the successful applicant or not.

In light of current events around Australia, all schools are revising their Emergency procedures. An important factor in any school processes is to ensure we have correct emergency contact details for parents. We will be asking parents soon to check the contact details that we have are correct. Please ensure the information we have is true and correct.

The grade 6 uniforms have arrived and the design this year looks terrific. Each year grade 5 students are given the opportunity to design the jumper for the following year. The creativity that is demonstrated each year gives us great Pride.

Our uniform policy is very clear and does not allow for netball skirts or other variations. Please be aware that staff will commence follow up procedures on students not in correct uniform as per our policy next week. It is parents responsibility to ensure students are dressed correctly for school.

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Student behaviour and misbehaviour impacts not only on the learning of themselves but the learning of their peers. Teaching time is valuable therefore teacher's time needs to be focused on 'teaching'.

Whilst some students require extra support to stay focused and maintain a standard of behaviour that does not disrupt the learning of others, the teachers have reported that the majority of students have settled in to a positive attitude to their learning this year.

If your child does need extra support, staff will work with you towards achieving a successful management plan with the specific purpose of improved learning.

Teachers are currently working on individual education plans for students who require extra support. Parents will be provided a copy of these plans when they are ready.

Attending school every day and being on time is important to all children's education. Each day involves viewing, reading and conversations about topic content which is not repeated. The beginning of the day is critical to the set up of learning routines and our Literacy block begins at 9.00 am. Reading is essential for all areas of learning.

Our future newsletters will be providing parents with updates on the attendance rates within the school. You can assist and support your child to be part of their learning community goals of excellent attendance through ensuring their regular and punctual attendance.

For student safety, late arrivals must be escorted to the office and signed in by an adult.

Dropping off students is a busy time and we understand some parents allow their children to get out of the car and walk themselves in. It has been brought to our attention this is sometimes done on the road side of parked cars. This is an extremely unsafe practice. The section of road along the Russell St side of the school has been established as a 'drop off' zone. We encourage parents to use the drop off zone. To support this practice in the mornings, could parents who are leaving their cars to escort their children in to school please NOT park on the school side of the road in Russell St. Please also be aware that because this is tagged as a drop off zone cars left unattended and / or parked for longer than two minutes will be fined by Council traffic patrollers.

Each year our School Council membership is reviewed. This year we will be seeking new members. School Council is a representation of staff and parents who work together to develop policy, school improvement and oversee financial management. We will be calling for nominations over the next couple of weeks. More information will be in next weeks newsletter.
