### **Developing responsibility.**

At CPS we take great pride in the work we do to help develop a sense of responsibility in our students. There are many things at place at school that help with this.

Students are expected to :

In 2015, the school enrolment is 250 and the student population is becoming more multi-cultural as the City of Casey grows. We currently run Learning communities at Junior, Middle and Senior levels. The school environment has a country feel to it, with well-established gum trees around the perimeter of the school grounds and buildings.

Cranbourne Primary School's dedication to sustainability, and teaching our students about ways to help the environment, is highlighted in our latest building upgrade initiative. We are excited to announce that we have recently undergone a complete roll-out of energy efficient lighting throughout Cranbourne Primary School.

Taking advantage of State Government subsidies under the VEET scheme, LED-specialist Shine On has replaced our old inefficient lighting with state of the art LED lighting. Being a VEET-accredited specialist in retrofits, Shine On has also ensured that all of the old lighting technology is recycled.

LED Lighting is drastically more efficient and offers numerous benefits. It is longer lasting, requires less maintenance, and emits a superior quality lighting output providing a far more conducive environment for our students to learn, read and write in.

The financial and environmental benefits are also great. We have achieved a 69% energy reduction, bringing down our lighting expenses substantially. Additionally, we have reduced our Co2 emissions by 31.5 Tonnes.

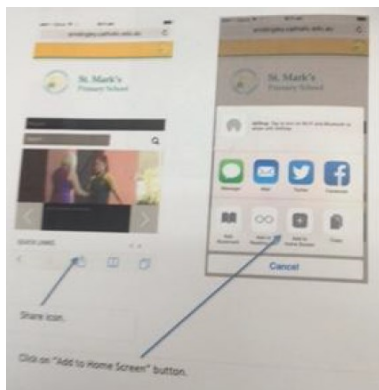
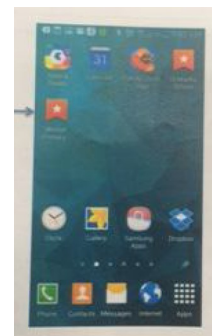
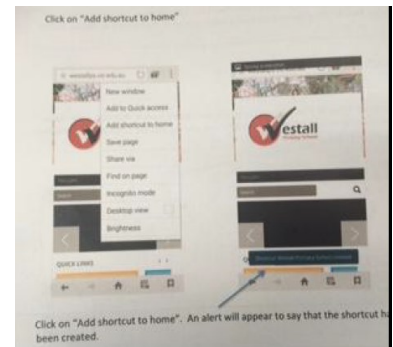
Pull down the menu bar (by swiping down from the top, this way you will see the address bar at the top of the screen).
