End of Year reports.

This time of year is a particularly busy time for teachers as they finalise assessments and write reports on students. Our teachers take great pride in ensuring these reports are as accurate and as up to date as possible, which can be tricky, given the timeline to finalise reports and print them, ready to present to families before the end of the year.

This semester's report is going to look slightly different to past reports. We are now able to "personalise" the format to suit our school, and reflect the areas of the curriculum covered in each semester.

Students will be given a rating, on a 4 point scale, on their effort and class behaviour for each area of the curriculum. This will enable teachers to give you a better idea of how your child 'performs', specific to each learning area/subject. As educators, we often find that students approach and behave differently in different subjects, dependent on how much they like it, how well they perform in that area, or whether they 'like' the teacher delivering that subject.

The new report format for Semester 2 will have information on what your child has achieved and areas for improvement/future learning. The sections "What the school will do" and "What you can do at home" have been omitted for the Semester 2 report.
