## Curriculum

### Reading at Home — Part 2

Changes to our Take Home Reading Program mean that students bring the same book home for a minimum of 2 nights. This will enable them to become more familiar with the text, have a deeper understanding of the meaning and help to develop their confidence in reading aloud with expression. On the first night your child brings the book home, it would be beneficial if you focussed on the following:

- ♦ Chat with your child about the book before they start to read it
- ♦ Look at the cover and make predictions
- ♦ Read the title – were any of our predictions correct?
- ♦ Read the book together. Encourage your child to have a go at working out unknown words for themselves, by using the reading strategies learnt at school
- ♦ Ask questions about the text
