To ensure the safety of all children, please note the following suggestions provided by <a href="https://www.safekids.org">www.safekids.org</a>

- Drive Extra Safely slow down and be especially alert in residential neighbourhoods.
- Children who are excited may move in unpredictable ways. Take extra time to look for kids at intersections, on median strips and on curbs.
- Enter and exit driveways and alleys slowly and carefully.
- Eliminate any distractions inside your car so you can concentrate on the road and your surroundings.
- Drive slowly, anticipate heavy pedestrian traffic and turn your headlights on earlier in the day to spot children from greater distances.
- Be especially alert for kids during the hours of 4 8.30pm.

If you are allowing your child to go 'trick or treating'

- Allow your child/ren to only door knock on houses you know.
- Make door knocking arrangements with your friends or neighbours so they are prepared.
- Narrow the area of travel to avoid main roads or crossings.
- Walk with your child/ren and provide responsible supervision.


