As you may already be aware, we run Investigations in our Junior School Learning Community. This is an approach to learning that is based on years of research, and is similar to the approach used in pre-schools.

Young children learn best through play, and while it is impractical for ALL learning at school to be "play" based, we can incorporate learning opportunities into our curriculum where children are engaged in hands on, play based learning. Activities are set up in areas, and students select an area according to their interests. The areas are set up by the teachers, and have specific learning goals and outcomes.

Everyone was standing on the side of the boat getting wet from the waves crashing on the side - it was so cold.






We are looking forward to our next day out to learn about protecting our marine life.
