CURRICULUM NEWS

Reports on Student Progress

Our teachers are continuously involved in the ongoing assessment and review of student progress and goal setting. This involves professional discussions, moderation, assessment tasks, extension and revision. All of this information is then shared with you, the parents and carer of our students, in the form of a written report.

Parents receive two written reports each year, at the end of each semester. You will receive Semester 1's report in the last week of this term. Your child's report will inform you about what they have achieved so far, areas for improvement, what you can do at home and what the school is going to do to assist in their progress.

The report is a combination of progression points to show where each child is currently achieving, and comments developed by the teachers that relate directly to your child and their learning.

This semester's report will look similar to past reports you may have received, but it will reflect the change over to AusVELS – the new curriculum that is leading to a National Curriculum. AusVELS is a combination of the new curriculum for English, Maths, Science and History with VELS for other curriculum areas.

We will provide you with more information later this term.


