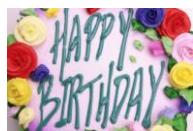

The objective of this activity was to explore the life and art of a focus artist, in this case Italian artist Amedeo Modigliani. The senior students were required to draw a self-portrait in oil pastels in his style, which required them to elongate their physical features and use solid blocks of colour in their background. They were also asked to experiment with the oil pastels using different techniques such as blending, smudging and layering.
