CPS Has Got TALENT!

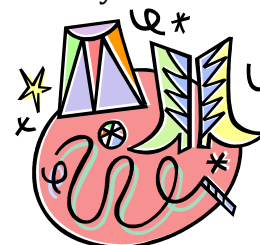
Just a reminder for all students that the auditions for CPS Has Got Talent are as follows:
