# In the Art room

In the Art room this term the students have been involved in a variety of activities - creating farmyard animals and scenes with Preps to making athletic sculptures with the Seniors.





The Prep students have used the farm and its animals as inspiration for their artworks. They have used collage to create fantastic farm scenes with fluffy sheep and chubby pink pigs.

The Junior school students have been studying Mini Beasts this term and have completed a range of activities using Mini Beasts as their starting point. At the moment there is a display of some of their work in the hallway outside the office. The students created silhouettes of a mini beast, which could be real or imagined; they then used oil pastels to decorate them with patterns. All three home groups contributed to the creation of the background for the Mini Beasts to explore.
