Student safety is a high priority in every school. Teachers are timetabled to provide supervision during times when students are outside.

Before school and after school duty times are 8.45-9.00am and 3.15-3.30pm. It is important that you are aware of the fact that adult supervision is not provided in the yard beyond these times, unless your child attends Breakfast Club. Breakfast Club operates inside the building with adults from 8.00am-8.30am.

It has been noticed by our community that some students are dropped off at the gate as early as 7.50am. This is not a safe practise. We ask all families to ensure the safety of their children by making alternative arrangements such as before school care, pairing up with neighbours, or making arrangements with friends or family to share transport closer to start and finish times.

The Breakfast Club has provided many students with the opportunity to have a meal before they commence their day of learning – health practioners advise that students who have eaten breakfast have a greater ability to concentrate and 'learn'.

Students who have regular breakfast, healthy snacks & lunches and drink sufficient water throughout the day are less likely to feel ill, get headaches or suffer from stomach aches, therefore, having more productive days at school.


STUDENT NEWS
