MEDICATION:

CURRICULUM NEWS

The current Specialist Programs at Cranbourne Primary School provide our students with extra learning opportunities in a wider variety of subject areas. Implementing these subjects helps us to address and support a greater scope of learning styles of our students.

Each child attends one hour sessions in Visual Art, Health and Physical Education, and Personal Development each week. Students across the school also have the opportunity to participate in extra Sport/P.E. sessions within their learning communities. Students also follow up skills/concepts addressed in Art and Personal Development within their learning space.

Although we do not have 'formal' specialist sessions to cover subjects such as Music and Science, our Learning Community teachers plan activities for these subjects that are integrated into the Units of Investigation. This enables us to address all subject areas included in VELS productively and strategically.

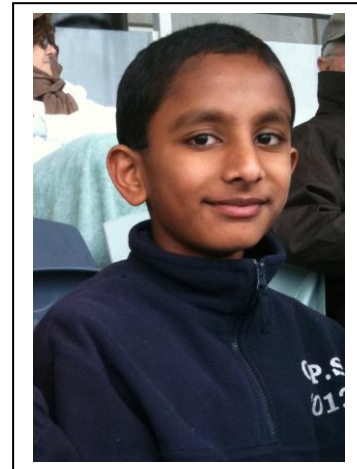
STUDENT NEWS
