MEDICATION:

CURRICULUM NEWS

We have finalised arrangements with Beleza, and production of our uniform is now underway. The amended uniform for 2013 will consist of navy blue "bottoms" (shorts, pants, culottes or skirts) with cobalt blue polo shirts. School dresses are also available in navy blue/white check.

If you have recently purchased plain blue shirts (without a logo) from Beleza and you would like to have the new logo printed on them, you can take shirts back to the store on **January 7, 2013**, and they will be ready to be picked up on **January 24 2013**. Staff at the Beleza store will take your contact details to inform you when your shirt has been printed.

Please make sure the shirts are clean and in good condition. Due to the heating process required, Beleza cannot guarantee the success of the print on shirts purchased elsewhere. There will be a cost of \$5.00 for each logo print. Families are able to place pre-orders with Beleza for new uniform items, ready for 2013.
