Personal safety and security of children, staff and volunteers (all persons on the premises) are of prime importance whilst in attendance at Cranbourne Primary School OSHC. Cranbourne Primary OSHC therefore takes a proactive approach to managing emergencies, developing emergency procedures and equipping staff and children with sound knowledge of them.

Procedures

- Smoke alarms are fitted in each room and are tested regularly in accordance to the manufacturer's instructions.
- There is an alarm bell for sounding warning of an emergency, which is kept in good working order, and tested regularly
- Exits are clearly marked and easily opened
- Cranbourne Primary School OSHC has appropriate fire extinguishers that are properly installed and maintained, and that staff have basic training in the use of the fire blankets and fire extinguishers kept at the venue. Locations will be clearly indicated by appropriate signage.
