2023 CSEF APPLICATION FORMS ARE NOW AVAILABLE

If you applied for CSEF (Camps Sports and Excursions Fund) through Cranbourne Primary School in 2022, you do not need to complete an application form in 2023 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools and you did not apply through
 Cranbourne Primary School in 2022
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number,
 or new siblings commencing at the school in 2023.



- 5. Once verified, log back into the app and enter the access key provided to you by the school to link to your child's details.


