

PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

As we come to the end of Term 1, I would like to take a moment to acknowledge what has been a very positive and productive term at Cranbourne Primary School. It has been wonderful to see the strong start our students have made and the pride they are showing in their learning and in our school community.

A highlight of the past week has been our Middle School Camp. I would like to congratulate our students on the way they represented themselves and the school, embracing new experiences and demonstrating independence, resilience and teamwork. My sincere thanks to the Middle School team for their work in supporting students throughout the camp, and in particular to Mrs Hare for her organisation and leadership of this important event.

We also recently celebrated Harmony Day, which was a wonderful reflection of our beautifully diverse and inclusive school community. Thank you to Ms Whittle for her organisation, and to our staff for designing engaging and inclusive activities that allowed students to learn about and celebrate different cultures.

As we move into the term break, I would like to remind families of our after-school pick-up routines. We ask that families continue to wait outside the school grounds until gates open at 3:00pm and avoid gathering near classrooms to ensure learning is not disrupted. Your support in maintaining a calm and orderly environment at the end of the day is greatly appreciated.

You may have noticed that works have now commenced on the new toilet facilities. As part of this, the gates along Russell Street will be closed during the construction period. A temporary gate has been installed near the gym for OSHC and The Hub only and will not be open for general school drop-off or pick-up. Students should enter and exit via the Bakewell Street gate, using the crossing. This is important, as opening the temporary gate during these times may lead to unsafe crossing of Russell Street. We will continue to monitor this arrangement and make adjustments if required.

I would also like to remind families that toys from home should not be brought to school, as they are increasingly causing issues in both the classroom and the yard. Students who require sensory supports will continue to be provided with these at school. If a student requires a specific item, this will be organised in consultation with their teacher and/or the wellbeing team. We ask that families do not send these items from home unless this has been agreed upon, as the school has appropriate resources available to support students.

A reminder that the last day of term is this Thursday, with an early finish at 2:30pm. I would like to wish all of our students, families and staff a safe and happy holiday break.

Thank you for your ongoing support throughout Term 1. I look forward to welcoming everyone back for another successful term ahead.

2026 CSEF APPLICATIONS CLOSE AT THE END OF TERM 2

If you applied for CSEF (Camps Sports and Excursions Fund) through Cranbourne Primary School in 2025, you do not need to complete an application form in 2026 unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- new student enrolments; your child has started or changed schools and you did not apply through Cranbourne Primary School in 2025
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing at the school in 2026.

Well done, Zoey and Ryan! We'll be cheering you on again at the Division Cross Country event in May.



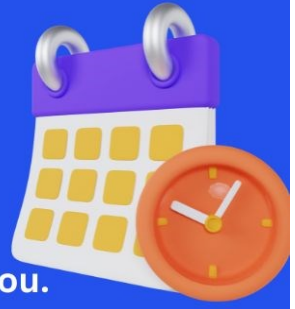
A reminder about collecting students early

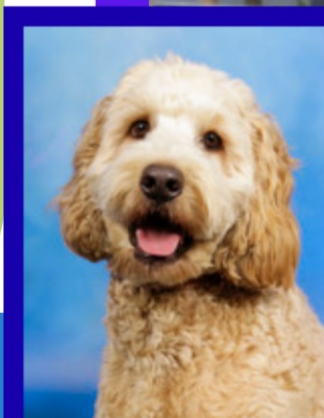
