We have received a great deal of positive feedback about the class-meetings that were run, and will be looking to run a similar event earlier in the year in 2024! I would particularly like to thank our Community Links team for organising so many of the stalls and activities. I would also recommend that any parents or guardians interested in supporting the school and building some great friendships should join their wonderful team.

We have started our school tours for 2024 enrolments! While we cannot confirm enrolments yet, we encourage anyone interested to book in a tour. I look forward to continuing to work with our wonderful student leaders, and we are already looking at our grade 4 students to identify next year's vice-captains.

Ten minutes late may not seem like much but over a week, that's a whole hour of lost learning. In an average term, that is 10hours of time away from important learning time.



A fun day had by all!!




































# CASEY LEADERS' SUMMIT




