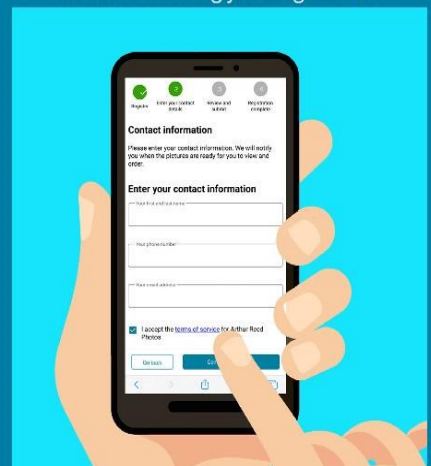

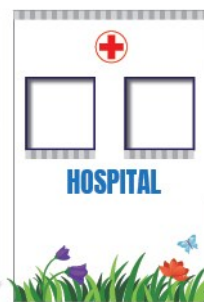

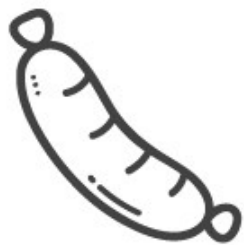

## SENTRAL FOR PARENTS APP

The Sentral for Parents app allows families to:

- \* View academic reports
- \* Explain past and upcoming student absences
- \* Message your child's classroom teacher
- \* View calendar events
- \* Book parent/teacher interviews
- \* Receive sick bay notifications
- \* View school documents
- \* View school newsletters

Instructions for accessing the Sentral for Parent app.

1. Download the "Sentral for Parents" app. Depending on your device, visit either the Apple App Store, or the Google Play Store
2. Search for Cranbourne Primary School. Tap Next.
3. Click Register here to register a new account (You must use a valid email address to create your username)
4. You will receive a verification email which MUST be verified in order to continue
5. Once verified, log back into the app and enter the access key provided to you by the school to link to your child's details.
