PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

It has been another wonderful fortnight at Cranbourne Primary School. Due to a number of staff absences, I was lucky enough to attend the Grade 3/4 camp. Students demonstrated wonderful behaviour, and the camp staff commented frequently on the strong positive relationships between our staff and students, and how helpful everyone was. Students had a wonderful time, and I would like to thank the teachers and ES who gave up time from their families to make everything run!

On Friday we will have another free excursion, this time to Bunjil Place for the Japanese Drumming workshop. I have heard very positive reports about their skills, so I am looking forward to visiting in one of the sessions. I hope students are looking forward to another wonderful excursion. This free excursion is part of our 3 year partnership with Musica Viva, who are providing us with 2 free incursions/excursions a year, money for new musical instruments and a musician in residence. We are grateful for their support, and Mrs Houlder has done an outstanding job in arranging such a great partnership.

Student behaviour has been a major concern of ours this term, and I am pleased to report an improvement across the school, particularly in the yard. A reminder that physical violence is never OK, and if students are worried or feel threatened they should immediately seek out a teacher, rather than try to address the issue themselves when they are feeling angry. Our staff are skilled at fixing problems they are made aware of. We strongly discourage parents giving advice such as "stand up for yourself", as this is resulting in children being hurt, with no resolution of the core issues.

We have been fortunate to partner with Foodbank Australia for some free cooking classes and hampers for some of our families. They have been cooking up some sensational dishes recently, and the smells have been making me incredibly hungry. Thanks to families who took us up on our offer, and we will continue to advertise similar opportunities in the future.

The works around the school continue to be developed. You will have noticed the shipping containers are both gone, and we are working with the Department of Education to have the old portable toilets removed. Works have also started on our Community Kitchen, and we are hopeful it will be ready for use by early next term. We will also be adding some walls in the Junior spaces to reduce noise and help student concentrate.

I would like to welcome our new OSHC coordinator, Valerie to the school. She has a wealth of experience in the sector, and we are making plans for Vacation Care to run in the upcoming school holidays. Final details will be released shortly. The school run service operates at a very low price while still providing a high level of quality care. If you are interested in enrolling, please contact the front office.

Teachers are all busy writing reports, ready for distribution at the end of term. We will be running parent-teacher interviews at the end of Term 2 again so the reports are fresh in everyone's minds. Because of interviews, we will also be finishing the last day of Term 2 (Friday 23rd June) at 2:30pm.

I hope everyone has a safe end of the term, and is able to stay warm. A reminder that we will not be running our assembly this Friday due to the music excursion, but I will see you the fortnight afterwards!

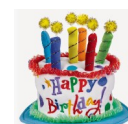

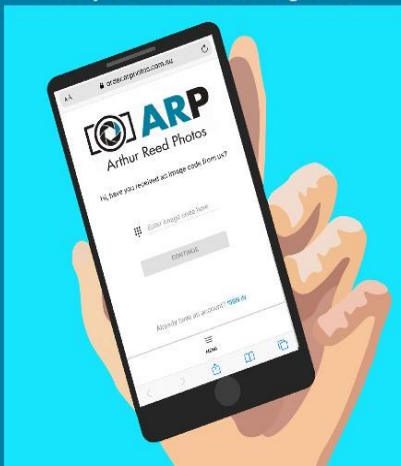

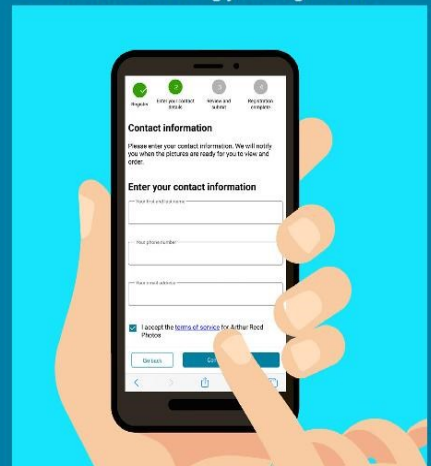

- 4. You will receive a verification email which MUST be verified in order to continue**
