Together, we can build a caring, inclusive, and supportive school community where everyone feels valued and supported.



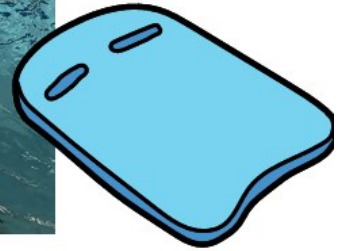

NEW SCHOOL CROSSING

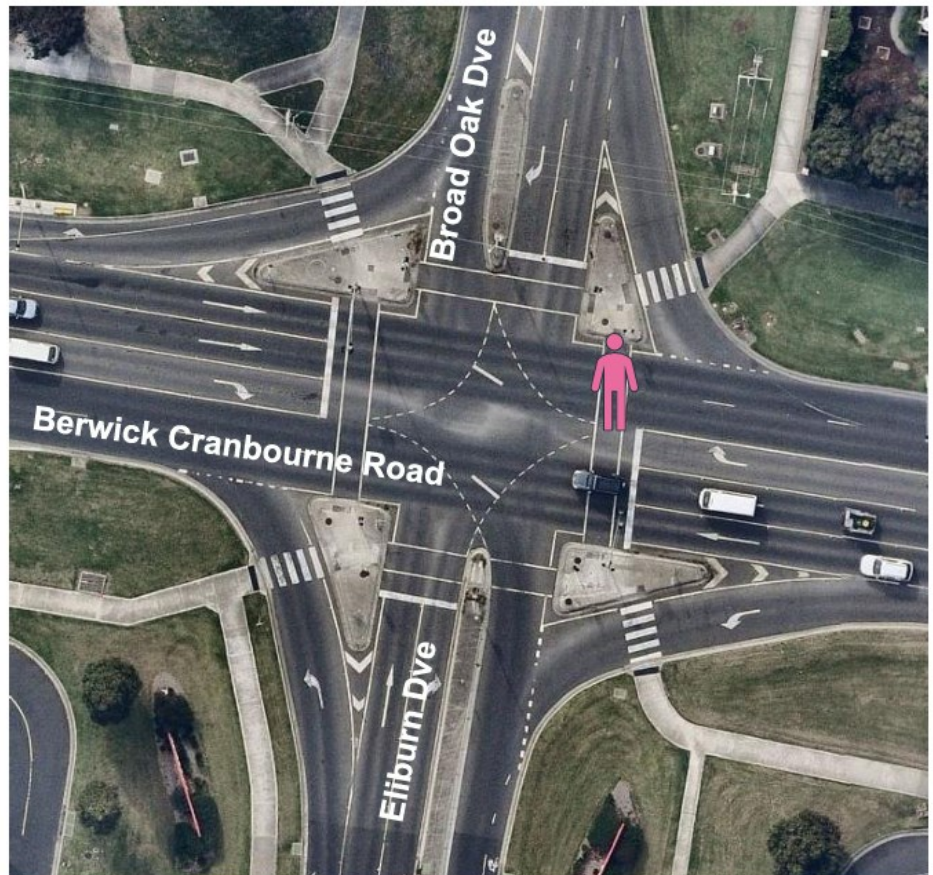
Berwick Cranbourne Road / Eliburn Drive / Broad Oak Drive

Addition of Supervisor

At the traffic lights near your school, pedestrian movements are controlled by the signals when they are followed correctly. However, interactions can still occur with turning vehicles, including right turns from Eliburn Drive into Berwick Cranbourne Road.

To further support safe crossing behaviours at this location, Council is introducing a School Crossing Supervisor on the north-eastern side of the intersection (Broad Oak Drive approach – marked with a pink person) from 13 July.

The Supervisor will assist students and families to use the pedestrian operated signals correctly and reinforce safe crossing practices during peak school times, particularly where vehicle turning movements occur.



We encourage all students to use the crossing on the north-eastern side where the Supervisor will be located. Families are also encouraged to talk with their child about using this crossing point and following safe crossing behaviours.

SAFE AROUND SCHOOLS



Getting children to school safely is everyone's job.

Tips for Walking to School



- » Plan a safe way for your child to get to school.
- » At every road crossing, remember Stop, Look, Listen and Think.
- » Talk to your child about road safety using simple words.
- » Walk or ride together to help your child learn the route.
- » Encourage your child to walk with others when possible.
- » Work with other families to set up walking groups.



Safely crossing at pedestrian lights

You must follow the traffic lights when crossing the road.

When crossing:

- » Stop, press the button and wait.
- » Cross only when the green man appears.
- » Make sure all traffic has stopped before stepping onto the road.
- » Keep looking and listening while crossing.
- » If the red light starts flashing, keep crossing safely.
- » Do not start crossing on a red light, even if it is flashing.
- » Get off bikes and scooters and walk them across.
- » Hold balls and do not bounce them while crossing.

Do not:

- » Cross the road when the red man is showing.
- » Cross within 20 metres of a crossing — always use the crossing.
