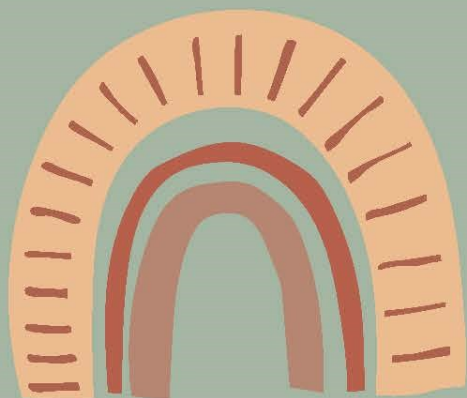

A Note on Staff Absences

In fact, Maneesha's riddle has officially stumped us all and remains unsolved:

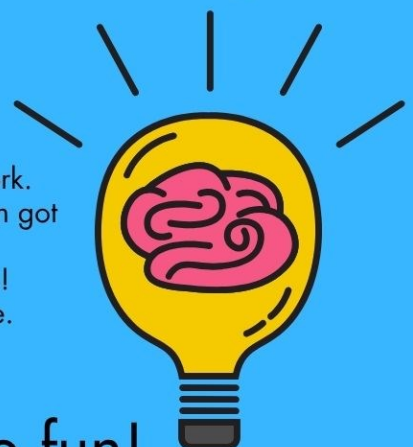
"What has 4 wheels and flies?"

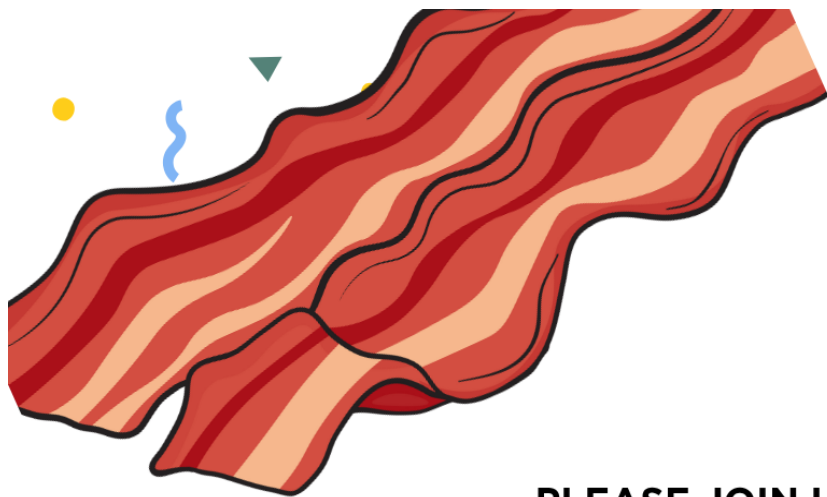


It was an inspiring and entertaining experience that sparked rich discussions in the classroom and music class
