## PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

Next week is a BIG week for our students in grade 3 and grade 5. On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday those students will be participating in the National Assessment Program Literacy & Numeracy (Naplan) assessments.

This involves students in grade 3, 5, 7 and 9 across Australia sitting the same test at the same time. The tests are academic and there is one test for Reading, one for Writing, one for Mathematics and one for Language Conventions. Students are allocated a set time to complete the test. To support our students to gain confidence in completing these assessments, teachers have been conducting practice sessions where tasks are set in similar test like conditions. This has been done to reduce any anxieties associated with sitting tests and raise students' confidence in their ability to achieve their best in a limited time.

Information from the Naplan data is used to evaluate the school's curriculum and teaching focus for the following year. The data is also used to evaluate school progress.
