The RSPCA lessons continue next week where they learn about safety around animals.

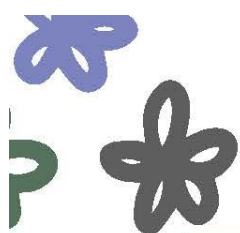
