PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

Hello everyone. It is with some degree of sadness that I write the last newsletter for the year to our school community.

This year has been a busy one, and the coming few weeks are no exception. We have events such as Graduation, Transition Day, our End of Year Concert and our free Whole School Excursion! There will be something for everyone in the coming weeks, and we look forward to seeing everyone there. Classes are also busy with their own activities, and I know that in addition to finishing off their learning, teachers have organised final class parties, Christmas Craft and a range of other fun activities to round out the year. Our whole school excursion on Friday 15th will be our last day with regular classes, as we are aware many families may choose not to send children on Monday, to get a strong start to the holidays. Families are still encouraged to send kids, and activities will be organised. Tuesday will be the official start to the school holidays for children, as teachers will be spending Tuesday and Wednesday getting everything ready for a great 2024!

The holidays will kick off with our first Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) excursion. This subsidised excursion is a great reason to enrol your child in OSHC and apply for the Government's Child Care Subsidy. By enrolling in our OSHC with the subsidy, it makes it easy to quickly enrol your child if you are working late or are catching up with friends. We encourage all families to complete their enrolment, just in case they need it (even if they aren't attending the upcoming excursion or using our vacation care).

Parents of children in older year levels will be aware of the "Ships" TikTok pages that have erupted in most primary schools in the area, and have been used as a vehicle for cyber-bullying. We are pleased that the Cranbourne PS account has been removed. We continue to encourage families to follow age restrictions on social media and games with chat functions (such as Roblox), and to limit and monitor screentime use. There is significant evidence about the impact social media has on children, and we encourage active monitoring.

As they get closer to finishing, I would like to publicly wish our Grade 6 students the best of luck in their future schooling. These students were in lockdowns through some critical times in their education, but have still become strong and capable young people who are ready to face the next stage of their education. I wish them good luck in the coming years, and hope they will return to the school!

I would also like to pay a special tribute to Belinda Walker. Belinda has been a staunch member of the school community and school council for many years. Her passion, energy and morals are incredible, and she has supported the school through some very challenging times. As a new principal, she has been a massive support through the huge changes we have made within the school over the last few years. While the best is yet to come at Cranbourne Primary School, in the last few years (with her support) we have seen the school move to having some of the best attendance, academic results and staff opinion survey results across local schools as we work hard to improve outcomes for all students. I thank Belinda for her tireless efforts and support, as both a long-term parent and president of School Council!

If we do not get to see you personally before the end of the year I wish you a Merry Christmas and hope that you and your families have a wonderful, happy and safe holiday break.

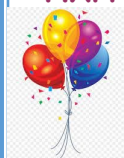

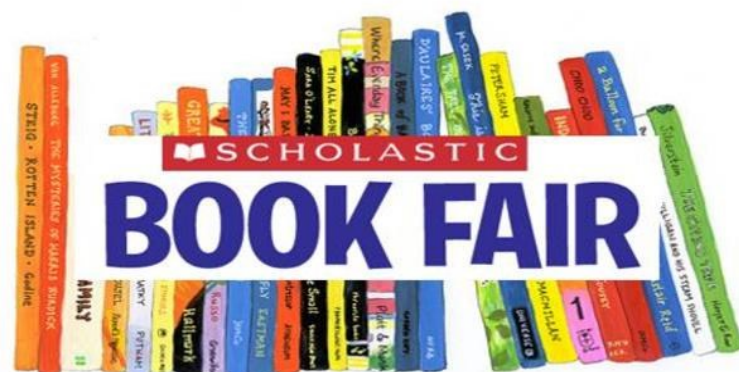
