## Farm Excursion

On Monday the 31<sup>st</sup> of August, the students from the Foundation and Junior Learning Communities visited Rain, Hayne and Shine Farm as part of our term 3 unit of inquiry: From Paddock to Plate. We all got on the buses and within two minutes of being on the road some children were already asking if we were there yet! Once we did get to the farm we had so much fun! We got to pick up and hold some animals such as rabbits, guinea pigs, chickens and ducks. We also got to milk a cow, grind wheat into flour and churn cream into butter. Once the butter was churned the students were able to eat the butter on a fresh piece of bread. We also got to see many other animals including cows, horses, goats, emus, peacocks, lambs, pigs and piglets.

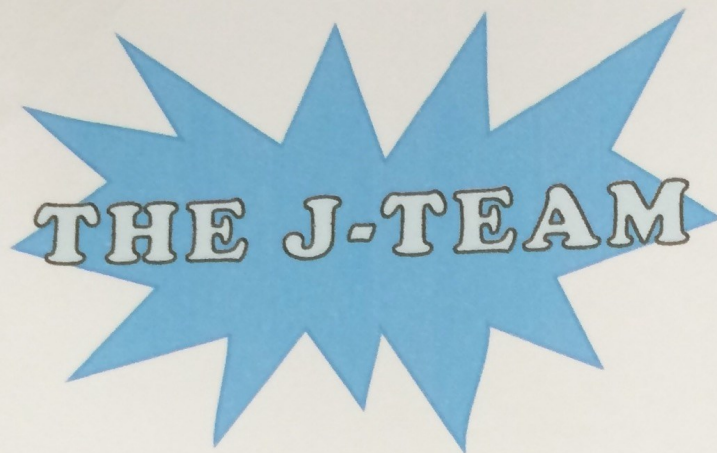

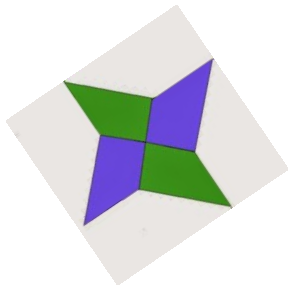
