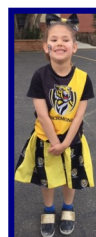

You may have heard about the recent DET initiative to address dental care and hygiene for school aged children. This initiative provides free dental services to students in government primary, secondary and special schools.

Our school has been identified to participate in this service. It will include an initial check up and oral health examination, followed by a treatment plan which may include follow up treatment if required.
