PRINCIPAL'S NEWS

The Melbourne Cup was held yesterday as it is every year. Did you know it is a handicapped race?

Did you know that the practice of <u>handicapping</u> that is used in horse racing always appears in some sports? Golf is a well known sport that applies handicaps to players. A handicap can be the addition of weight, score, time, distance or any variable that applies to the competition, with the purpose of creating a more equal competition.

The intention of a handicap horse race is to give every horse a chance to win. The handicapper does this by allocating a certain weight that each horse must carry during the race. This weight is in the form of ballast carried in the saddle-bags. The better the horse, the bigger the weight it carries. Older horses also carry a heavier load, compared to younger animals.

This principle is applied in many aspects of competition and seen on some TV shows. Time is used as a handicap in competitions like the amazing race, cooking competitions and even Leggo Masters.

Sometimes being the highest, strongest or fastest competitor is rewarded with a handicap.

Applications for 2020 CSEF are now open. If you applied for CSEF in 2019 at Cranbourne Primary School you do not need to complete an application form for 2020.


You only need to complete an application form if you are new to our school or your family circumstances have changed.


The fair will run From Monday 11 November through to Thursday 14th November, 2019.
