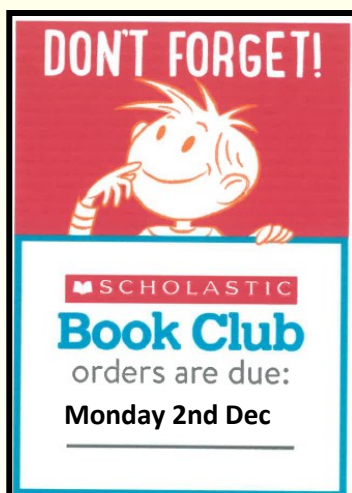

Please note the locations of learning communities will be different in 2020.

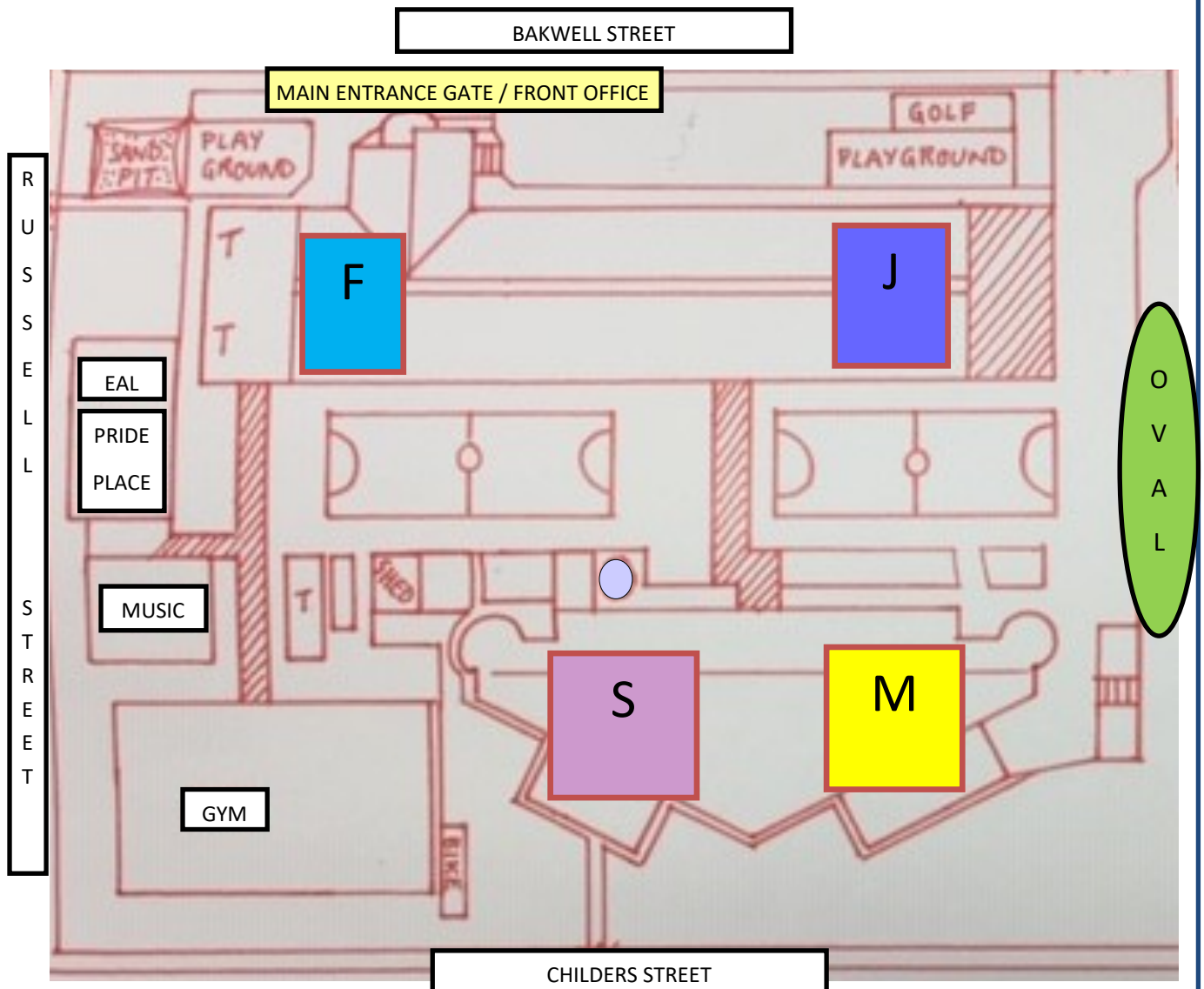
Students will be visiting their new spaces during transition sessions.

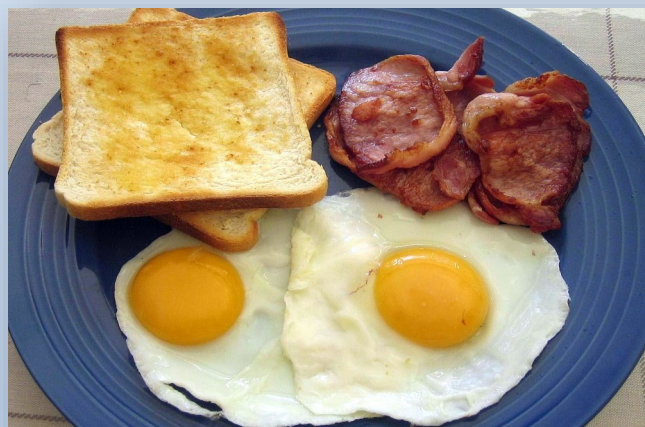
